
NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE!!!

UMFA: A tentative settlement has been reached at the University of Manitoba. Further details will be available after the membership has an opportunity to look at the final deal. A ratification vote will be held later this week. CONGRATULATIONS UMFA!!!

AESES: The AESES bargaining team is back to the table today. A strike date has been set for Monday, November 16th. UWFA has called a General Meeting to discuss this issue. (See page 2)

BRANDON: The BUFA membership went out on strike this morning (November 9th). According to Joe Dolecki, BUFA's President, conciliation efforts have failed to achieve a collective agreement. Mediation is to begin tomorrow morning, November 10th, with John Scurfield appointed as Mediator for the dispute. The main issues are monetary. BUFA is asking for a 10% increase over 5 years, while the university has countered with a 2.5% increase over 3 years.
